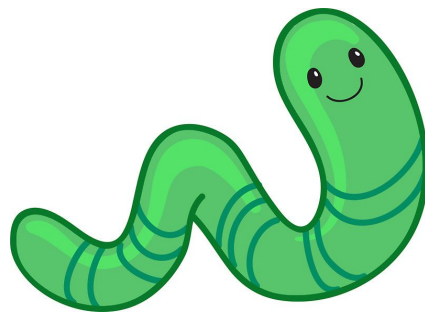

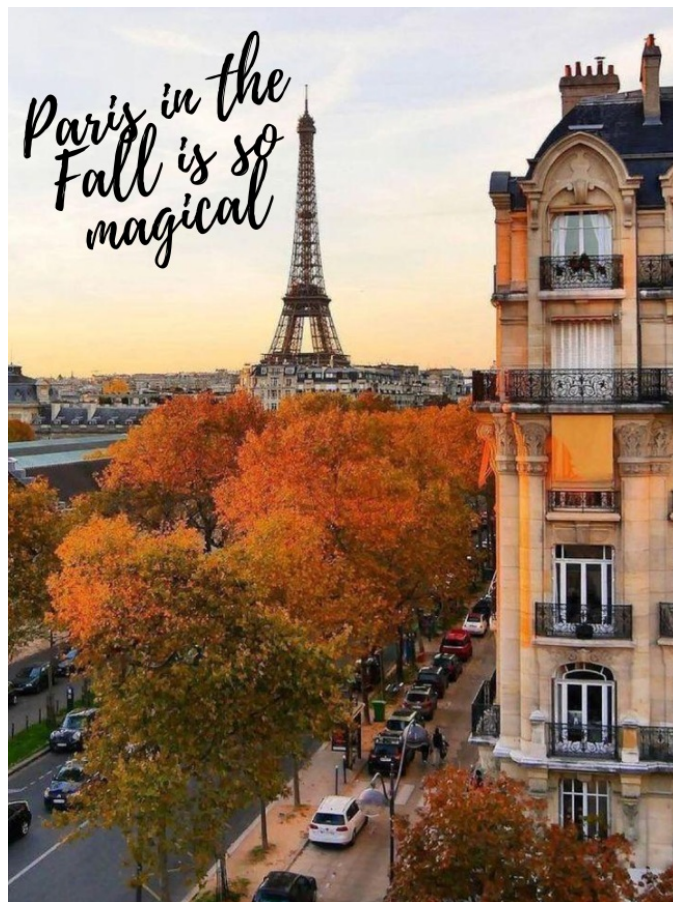

Come join us and expand your literary and linguistic horizons!

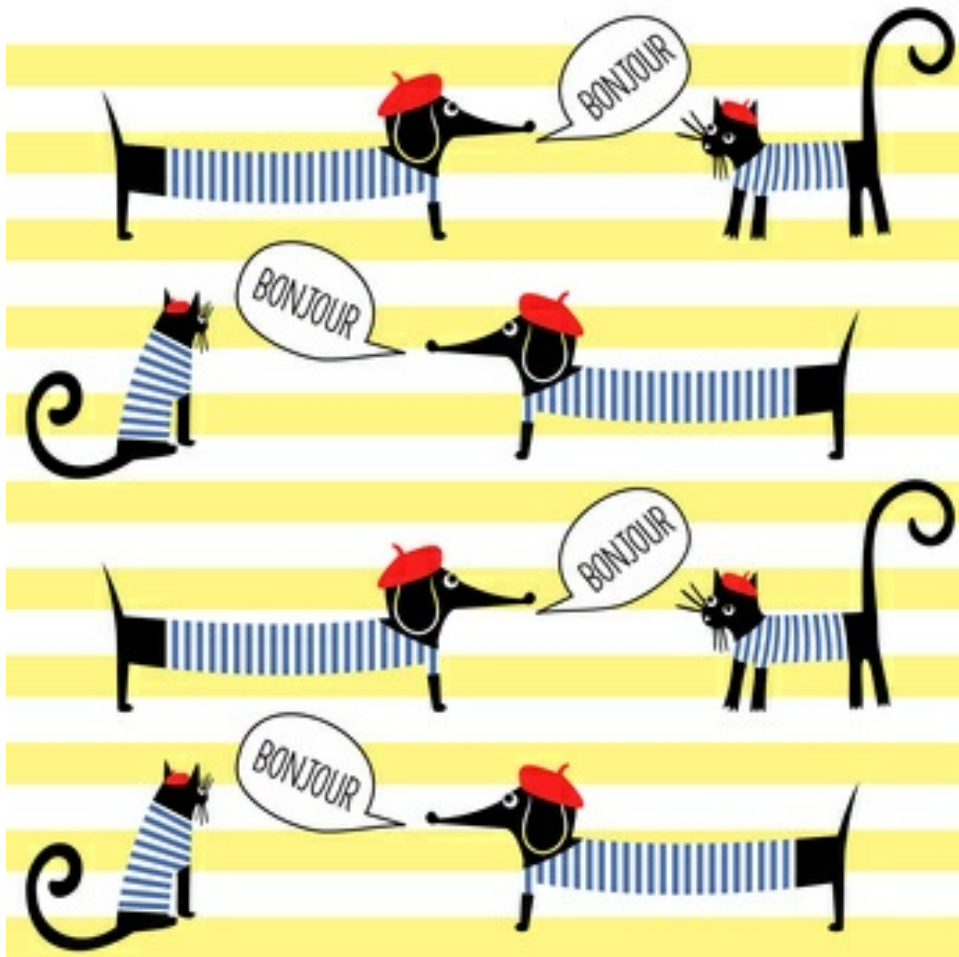
