

FAQ for French Summer Camp 2022

Hours of Operation / Drop Off & Pick Up Rules / Authorized Adults

Each camp will last for five days from 9:00am to 1:00pm. Please be sure to bring a face mask. Check in will be held between 8:50am and 9:15am each morning. Sign out will be done by 12:45-1:15pm. You must pick up your child by 1:15pm.

I can't pick up my child; can I ask someone else to pick him/her up for me?

Yes IF, the person is on your authorized pickup list (in the form you filled with us) OR if you email us (only written email will be valid, no phone call no text message) the name of your child, your name, and the name of the person plus phone number to add on the authorized list, please also note if you want the person to be authorized on only one specific date or for the duration of the camp.

IMPORTANT!

We will NOT release your child to a person under 18.

We will NOT release your child to anyone (even the parent of another child) who is NOT on your authorized pick up list or had been confirmed by email to Kevin

Every child MUST be signed in and out by an adult from the authorized list EVERY MORNING AND EVERY AFTERNOON. We will NOT allow any child to enter or leave the building if not accompanied by one authorized adult.

Your child MAY NOT come/leave alone by bus.

To Pack: MEALS & SNACKS

- Light Lunch
- Water Bottle
- Face Mask

On a few days, classes will prepare a light, French-themed snack as an activity. We will have juice boxes and fruit.

***Please let us know in advance if you child has food allergies so we may avoid them!**

What to do if we are running late / have a doctor appointment or need to pick up early?

What to do if my child is sick?

-Please stay home even if you think it's not Covid-related, email Kevin to let him know and take a Covid test ASAP! Let us know the results as soon as you have them.
